# **The imperative**

The imperative form is the same as the *bare infinitive*. It has only one form for both second person singular and plural 'you'

## Examples:

- *hurry up*; you'll be late
- *go out* immediately

In the negative form you add 'do not' or 'don't'

#### Examples:

- *Don't disturb* me; I'm working.
- Do not smoke!

## Use of the imperative

You can use the imperative to give instructions, commands, advice or to invite:

## 1. To give instructions

- *Push* the button
- Turn left

## 2. To give commands

- *Stop* saying nonsense
- Don't lie.

## 3. To give advice

- Go to hospital; you are ill
- Don't forget to take your passport with you

#### 4. To invite

- Please, *come* to the party
- Have a drink
